2011 FALL SOFTBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION**

1. **Total fee is \$275.00 for 8 games (two games a week) and a tournament. Balance of \$275.00 is due by August 29, 2011. We accept cash, check-(NA-FC Parks), and credit card.**
2. Roster/waiver list is due before your first scheduled game. Signatures/forms will be collected by the scorekeeper before your first game. Last date for roster changes is before third game is played.
3. Teams must be sanctioned "D" or below to play in leagues. All "E" teams will only be allowed to play a maximum of 2 "D" or above players. Rosters will be checked with all association roster lists.
4. Six weeks of play, 8 games. Each team plays two games per week. (Monday & Wednesday) or (Tuesday & Thursday)
5. The Parks Department must have at least four teams to run a league. The Parks Department reserves the right to place teams in the league.
6. Approved game balls will be chosen and provided by the Parks Department.
7. Rain out games will be made up:
  - I. - at the 9:30 game time if there is one.
  - II. - at the end of the season before the tournament.
  - III. - on Friday nights.
  - IV. - on Sundays.
8. **Leagues will begin the week of September 6, 2011.**
9. T-shirts will be awarded to league winners at team request. Logo/design will be chosen by the Parks Department. You may choose color of shirt. **No** special order shirts will be provided. Please make request within 2 weeks of the end of the league.
10. Sponsor plaques or trophies will be awarded to tournament winner at team request. Please make request within 2 weeks of the end of the league.
11. **All checks are deposited daily.** Any returned checks will be subject to a returned check fee **(\$25)**. If a team drops from the league before the league starts, a refund will be issued if another team can be found to replace that team. If another team cannot be found, half the fee will be refunded. No refund will be issued after the start of the season. The refund will be issued in four to six weeks.
12. All players participating in the NA-FC Department of Parks and Recreation Softball Leagues must sign the roster/waiver provided by the Parks Department. The Parks Department is not responsible for any injuries that may occur while participating in our leagues.
13. All communication will be by email unless short notice then by cell phone.
