2012 WINTER BASKETBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION**

1. Team franchise fee is \$300.00 for a minimum of 8 games (one game a week). There will be a tournament at the end of regular season play. Payment is due at the time you register. **Registration begins Monday November 14, 2011. Deadline to register is Friday, December 16th.** NA-FC Parks & Recreation accepts cash, check, or credit card.
2. Roster/waiver sheets are due by the start of your first game. Signatures will be collected by the scorekeeper before your first game begins. Last date for roster changes is before the start of your third played game.
3. Format for league play is 4 on 4 full court.
4. The Parks Department must have at least four teams registered in order to run a league. The Parks Department reserves the right to place teams when necessary.
5. Teams are responsible for providing their own game shirts/jerseys during league play. Player's tops must have a readable number on either the front or back of the top. During registration teams can coordinate with the athletic director which color top they have chosen to avoid duplicates among the teams.
6. NA-FC Parks & Rec/SISC will provide game balls. Teams are responsible for bringing their own balls for warm-ups.
7. Leagues will begin Thursday, January 12, 2012 at the S.I.S.C.
8. T-shirts will be awarded to league winners. Logo/design will be chosen by the Parks Department. **No** special order shirts will be provided. Teams will receive one T-shirt for every person that actually participated in the league.
9. All checks are deposited daily. Any returned checks will be subject to a returned check fee (\$25). If a team drops from the league before the league starts, a refund will be issued if another team can be found to replace that team. If another team cannot be found, half the fee will be refunded. **No refund will be issued after the start of the season.** The refund will be issued in four to six weeks.
10. All players participating in the NA-FC Department of Parks and Recreation Basketball Leagues must sign the roster/waiver provided by the Parks Department. The Parks Department is not responsible for any injuries that may occur while participating in our leagues.
